Defibrillators

Action taken:

1. Handover meeting with Rod Barker
2. Defibrillators at village hall and telephone box checked and found to be in working order
3. Report made via website to Community Heartbeat Trust
4. Rescue pack (mask, gloves etc) ordered for village hall site as none present
5. Contact made with Kirsten Jennings at Pontshill as reporting of defibrillator check there was overdue – check subsequently recorded online
6. Checked online that the check at Bailey Lane End had been carried out and reported
7. Contact made with Debbie Dowsett, logistics manager at Community Heartbeat Trust

VETS scheme

1. Circulated information regarding operation of the scheme during the coronavirus crisis
2. Asked VETS members to confirm or otherwise their wish to remain a volunteer

Issues for the future

1. Install rescue pack at village hall site as soon as possible
2. Organise training for defibrillators and first aid training for those villagers who wish to undertake it
3. Recruitment of further VETS volunteers
4. Training for VETS volunteers
5. Raising awareness of VETS scheme across the village
