As well as enduring the Covid 19 lockdown we have also had to suffer the persistent and intrusive noises that your farming activity has been making over the last weeks and seem to be getting worse and more intense .

I refer to the machine noises being used to trim, mow and dust your fruit crop at Pontshill. This noise continues for hours throughout the day and at weekends.

It pervades through the walls into the house, so even sitting inside, having been forced indoors, I cannot escape the din !

I appreciate your enterprise is important to provide food for the nation but I would be most grateful if some greater consideration could be made for the local residents who have to suffer the associated noise levels.

It is hardly usual for a fruit farm to have as great an audible impact as much as that of an industrial factory but this is where things have got to.

I would be most grateful if you could explore investing in quieter machinery if this activity has to continue through the year.

Our wellbeing is already being tested, so this additional stress is not at all welcome.

We would appreciate it if the people living adjacent to your land were shown some consideration by some action being taken to make our lives a little more bearable please, and peaceful.
